As part of the organizational process for the **2026 World NANBUDO Championship**, known as "**MONDIAL NANBUDO 2026**", to be held in **Yaoundé, CAMEROON**, from **October 1 to 4, 2026**, the second of six (six) International Organizing Committee meetings scheduled took place on the **April 18, 2026** on video conference. The first Meeting had been organized in **Casablanca, MOROCCO**, in a hybrid format (in-person and online) on **January 24, 2026**.

The agenda outlined above was carried out as follows:

I- Opening by the IOC President

The session was opened by the **President of the International Organizing Committee (IOC)**, who began by emphasizing the importance of this major competition for the development of our martial art, as well as the significance of an African country hosting the event for the first time.

He made a point of clarifying the issues regarding the delays in sending out invitations to participate to the various listed countries, explaining that this was due to the WNF awaiting clarifications from the host country regarding its actual responsibility for providing food and lodging for all foreign athletes.

He concluded his opening remarks by congratulating the Local Organizing Committee and especially President Prof. Justine DIFFO on all that has been accomplished so far and on the plans in place to ensure the complete success of this event.

II- Introduction by the LOC President

Next, the **President of the Local Organizing Committee (LOC)** took the floor to outline the strategic initiatives that have been completed or are currently being implemented:

1. The Government of Cameroon agrees to provide **full board (room and board) for all competitors arriving in Cameroon** for the 2026 World NANBUDO Championship
2. The number of **Referees to be covered** will remain in accordance with the budget and terms of reference submitted by FECANANBUDO to the Cameroonian Ministry of Sports and Physical Education and shared with the IOC President.
3. The Cameroonian government will only be able to provide one-quarter of the budget initially required to organize the competition. This means that, in order to secure the necessary funds, we must step up our efforts to seek out sponsors across the board, primarily through strong online visibility and effective marketing.
4. The President of the LOC was able to establish contact with the Dean of the Diplomatic Corps in Cameroon, **the Ambassador Plenipotentiary of EQUATORIAL GUINEA**, who has committed to supporting the 2026 WORLD NANBUDO CHAMPIONSHIP by facilitating official contacts through the organization of a Diplomatic Dinner attended by the Ambassadors of all participating countries, notably that of JAPAN.
5. Unfortunately, there has been criticism of the WNF's lack of communication regarding the event; **even on its website, there is no mention of it whatsoever**, much to the surprise of senior officials eager to learn more. She urges the **WNF** to step up its communication efforts regarding this event in order to ensure the participation of a greater number of countries.
6. The President of the LOC has committed to forwarding all communications to the IOC President as soon as possible.
7. A **website** has been set up for this event; to visit it, simply search for "**MONDIAL NANBUDO 2026**".
8. A Competition known as **TINPA (International Tournament of Friendly Nations)**, originally scheduled for April 24 and 25, 2026, has been rescheduled for **June 24–27, 2026**, to allow the invited countries more time for preparation (both administrative and technical). This competition, which will serve as a trial run, aims to reassure the Cameroonian government of the CLO's organizational capabilities to ensure the success of the 2026 WORLD NANBUDO CHAMPIONSHIP.
9. Remarks by the **IOC President** to provide some clarification:
 - a. *He noted a certain breakdown in communication following the official announcement press conference on February 20, 2026;*
 - b. *He promises to step up international communication, particularly as soon as he receives the minutes of this meeting;*
 - c. *He emphasizes that greater importance should be placed on maximizing the number of participating countries rather than the number of competitors.*

- d. He would like CINDA to be responsible for selecting international referees instead of setting a limited number per country. He simply requests that CINDA be provided with the number of airline tickets allocated by Cameroon for the referees.

10. **Me Nestor MBOUMI** will provide a detailed breakdown of the number of referees per country as specified in the Terms of Reference and will note that it is not possible to simply report the number of airline tickets reserved for referees, since prices vary depending on the departure location.

III- Presentation of the LOC's progress report by the Tournament Director + Discussion

The **Tournament Director** will then take the floor to present the work carried out so far by the CLO in preparation for the 2026 WORLD NANBUDO CHAMPIONSHIP, covering the following points:

1. **Brand Elements of the 2026 WORLD NANBUDO CHAMPIONSHIPS:** The **Logo**, **Anthem**, and official **Mascot** of the 2026 NANBUDO WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS have been unveiled (see *Appendices*).
2. **Expected Participating Countries:** A current list of **25 potential participating** countries has been compiled, with ongoing communication established with 20 nations. To this list, EQUATORIAL GUINEA must be added (See *Appendices*).
3. **Competition Venue:** The competition will take place at the same venue as the 2024 African NANBUDO Nations Championship, at the **Yaoundé Multipurpose Sports Palace (PAPOSY)** (See *Appendices*). Based on the WNF and CINDA specifications, as well as experience gained from previous competitions, a list of requirements was submitted to the administration of this facility for the period from September 30, 2026, to October 5, 2026.

The PAPOSY management responded with a pro forma quote for an exorbitant amount of **33,000,000 FCFA (thirty-three million FCFA)**, about **€50,000**. A team comprising President **Prof. Justine DIFFO** and the National Technical Director, Vice President of the CLO, **Me Moger AYEM**, will meet with PAPOSY management to negotiate a lower price for this service.

5. Press Conference on February 20, 2026: A press conference officially announcing Cameroon's hosting of the 8th World NANBUDO Championship was held with great success on **Friday, February 20, 2026**, in Yaoundé, Cameroon, in the presence of **Institutional Officials, Diplomatic Representatives**, and several **Sponsors**. (Images in Attachments).

6. Incident reported by MOROCCO: It was noted during the press conference on February 20, 2026, that the **MOROCCO flag** was not only of poor quality but, more importantly, that the proportions of the green star did not meet standards. The President of the LOC and the Tournament Director offered their sincere apologies for this incident, clarifying that these flags were not those made for the event, but rather a donation from well-meaning individuals.

The President of the NANBUDO MOROCCO Foundation, **Me Mustapha BOUMYA**, clarified that the remark was made by dissident critics of the WNF who are just waiting for an opportunity to sabotage and even derail this event. These remarks were reinforced by the President of the LOC with references to similar incidents that occurred in Cameroon.

It was agreed that, in addition to the information on the emblems of the various countries that we plan to obtain through diplomatic channels (*flags and national anthems*), each NANBUDO Country Representative must provide the CLO with a description of their country's flag to avoid such errors.

7. Other scheduled press briefings:

- **Press briefing to officially present the status of preparations:** 3 months before the event.
- **Press briefing for the official launch of the event:** September 30, 2026, on the sidelines of the draws.

8. Accommodations: Negotiations are underway to secure the MONT FEBE Hotel in Yaoundé for athlete accommodations (See attached images).

9. TINPA (International Tournament of Friendly Nations): This international tournament, rescheduled for **June 24–27, 2026**, will allow the LOC to hone its skills. The following nations will be invited: **France, Morocco, Ivory Coast, CAR, and Cameroon.**

10. Dashboards & Task Scheduling: A meticulous management and monitoring system has been implemented to ensure the smooth progress of the preparations for the 2026 WORLD NANBUDO CHAMPIONSHIPS, as follows:

- The President of FECANANBUDO has established a Local Organizing Committee consisting of a **General Coordination, a Tournament Direction, and 10 Technical Committees.**
- Clear **Missions and Objectives** have been assigned to each of the above entities.
- These **Missions and Objectives**, supported by the experience gained from previous events, have been broken down into tasks covering the period from July 2025 to December 2026.
- Thus, a **Dashboard** for tracking these various tasks has been implemented for each entity (including the WNF and CINDA), specifying the following elements: **Tasks, Performance Indicators, Deadlines, Required Resources, Person in Charge, Constraints, and Risks.**
- Each entity has completed its Dashboard and returned it to the Tournament Management, which has established a **Tasks Schedule** that will now enable meticulous, chronological tracking of the expected tasks based on **Performance Indicators, Deadlines, and Responsible Persons.** It will also enable effective planning for the timeline of the 2026 WORLD NANBUDO CHAMPIONSHIP and, consequently, better management of unforeseen events.
- A summary has been compiled for an **Overall Tasks Schedule** of all tasks related to the 2026 NANBUDO World Championships: a **120-page** document covering a total of **1,118 Tasks.** It will now serve as **the daily guide for managing** the 2026 World NANBUDO Championship.
- An update on the Tasks Scheduling for the WNF/CINDA, as well as for all LOC entities, will be covered in the following sections.

IV- Tasks Schedule of WNF + CINDA for the 2026 World NANBUDO Championship

The **Tournament Director** provided an update on the WNF/CINDA Task Schedule (see Annexes). It turned out that there was a significant delay in the organization, and the only task completed was CINDA's transmission of the **2026 World NANBUDO Championship Rules.**

The Tournament Director urged the WNF to expedite the process of sending invitations to the listed countries in order to obtain, as soon as possible, the list of countries actually registered for the competition and the athletes registered for the events; this data is awaited by most of the LOC Commissions to continue their work.

The IOC President, who is also Vice President of the WNF, reassured everyone that invitations for the expected countries and even letters for potential sponsors are currently being prepared.

V- Progress of the Work of the LOC Technical Committees

1- The GENERAL COORDINATION – COORD-GEN

The **General Coordination** is responsible for overseeing the activities of the LOC's entities through strategic management and the ongoing pursuit of the resources necessary for the successful execution of the event.

2- The TOURNAMENT DIRECTION – DT

The **Tournament Direction** ensures that all RISKS that could affect the event are taken into account; it also coordinates the work of the various Technical Committees and maintains constant communication with the General Coordination Office. It is currently preparing the **Risk Management Plan for the 2026 WORLD NANBUDO CHAMPIONSHIP**.

3- The Medical and Anti-Doping Commission – COM-MED

The **MEDICAL and ANTI-DOPING Commission** handles the medical aspects:

- ✓ She defined 03 **Sanitary Cordons** :
 - **First Perimeter (Competition Area)**, consisting of a station around each of the three competition areas (1 physician + 1 physical therapist + 1 nurse), in addition to a station staffed by a supervising sports medicine specialist;
 - **2nd Perimeter (Stands)** managed by the RED CROSS;
 - **3rd Perimeter (Entire PAPOSY + surrounding area)** managed by the Operational Health Directorate (Military).
- ✓ **Volunteer Doctors** will be called upon to support the event. **Delegations that do not bring their own doctor will be assigned one.** Health Monitoring will be maintained even in the hotels.
- ✓ A fully equipped medical clinic will be available on site, staffed by **Doctors, Physical Therapists, and Nurses**;
- ✓ **Ambulances** will be available in addition to **10 reserved Beds** at the nearest referral hospital;
- ✓ **Medical examinations** will be required of each participant before the start of the competition; without them, the participant will not be allowed to take part. The option to undergo these examinations on-site will be arranged upon request;
- ✓ A **Medical Code** will be presented to each participant, to be followed during the competition.

4- The REFEREEING Commission – COM-ARB

The **REFEREEING Commission** ensures that CINDA receives on-site support so that it has everything it needs for the competition's refereeing. It is responsible for ensuring that **refereeing materials and**

equipment are available in sufficient quantity and quality and comply with the CINDA Specifications during the competition.

It is responsible for implementing a strategy to upgrade Cameroonian referees in order to present **30 Cameroonian International Referees** to CINDA for final selection following the Referee Refresher Seminar on October 1, 2026.

5- **The HOSPITALITY, PROTOCOL, ACCOMMODATIONS, FOOD SERVICES, and TOURISM Commission – COM-ACCUEIL**

The **COM-ACCUEIL** is currently working to identify the accommodation options that best meet the specified criteria, while refining its strategy for welcoming and transporting participants. It is also working to organize pre- and post-competition sightseeing tours tailored to the needs of international visitors.

6- **The MARKETING & COMMUNICATION Commission – COM-MARK.COM**

The **COM-MARK.COM** is responsible for organizing all press conferences and ensuring they run smoothly. The company has developed a marketing kit to facilitate the search for sponsors. It is also tasked with implementing a **Communications Plan**, a **Media Plan**, a **Spectator Engagement Plan**, and a **Sponsorship Plan**.

7- **The SECURITY Commission – COM-SECU**

The **SECURITY Commission** is responsible for ensuring the effective and efficient security of **Competition Venues, Training and Warm-Up Areas, Locker Rooms and Specialized Facilities, Spectator Stands**, and even **Accommodations**. A multi-layered security system has been implemented, supported by:

- 25 Gendarmes
- 25 Policemen
- 60 Volunteers

8- **The MOBILIZATION and ANIMATION Commission – COM-MOBIL.ANIM**

The **COM-MOBIL.ANIM** is responsible for managing and monitoring the Mascot's activities for welcoming delegations and various ceremonies. It is responsible for ensuring the smooth organization of these ceremonies:

- African Business Forum;
- Drawing Ceremony;
- International Martial Arts and Combat Sports Festival;
- Opening and Closing Ceremonies of the 2026 WORLD NANBUDO CHAMPIONSHIP;
- Medal and Award Ceremonies;
- Opening Reception and Gala Evening.

9- **The PUBLIC RELATIONS and COOPERATION Commission – COM-REL.PUB.COOP**

The **COM-REL.PUB.COOP** is responsible for managing all aspects related to administrative and consular procedures, as well as relations with external entities. This commission has already contacted all diplomatic missions, particularly that of **NORWAY**, to draft a letter outlining the actual security situation in Cameroon, which has recently hosted two international events: a **WTO Meeting** (involving over 160 countries) and the **Pope's Visit**. The letter will be sent to the Norwegian delegation to reassure them.

10- The ADMINISTRATION Commission – COM-ADMIN

The **ADMINISTRATION Commission** handles all administrative aspects: issuing and tracking correspondence to be sent to and forwarded to external entities. It has already prepared around twenty letters covering almost all targeted entities: **Ministries of Sports, Commerce, Defense, Tourism, SMEs, Territorial Administration, the Police, the Gendarmerie, Airlines, Large Companies, etc.**

11- The INFRASTRUCTURE, LOGISTICS, and SITE's MAINTENANCE Commission – COM-INFRA.LOG

The **COM-INFRA.LOG** is responsible for infrastructure monitoring and all necessary logistics. Its responsibilities will include:

- Security Badges and Armbands;
- Tatami mats;
- Flags and Signs;
- Flag-raising Equipment;
- NANBUDO Store;
- Real-time score display;
- Real-time video recording equipment (VAR).

12- The ETHICS & DISCIPLINE Commission – COM-ETHIQ

The **ETHICS & DISCIPLINE Commission** is responsible for all aspects related to ethics, discipline, and fair play among all stakeholders. It will provide a Code of Ethics, which each stakeholder will be required to sign. It will ensure compliance with the rules in the event of requests for doping controls.

VI- Contributions from the Tournament Director on Management Issues

The **Tournament Director** emphasized the importance of consistently maintaining a **Participative Management** approach based on **Collective Intelligence**. He believes that every member of the Local Organization Committee should be encouraged to make any suggestions they deem relevant, useful, or innovative.

He reiterated the need to constantly bear in mind the origins, constraints, and unique characteristics of the 2026 WORLD NANBUDO CHAMPIONSHIP, which necessitate meticulous planning to ensure its success, including:

1. The organization of the 2026 World NANBUDO Championship was awarded to Cameroon based on the **success of the 2024 African Nations Championship (CHAN)** through the application of Participative Management.
2. The 2026 World NANBUDO Championship received the **HIGHEST APPROVAL of the Cameroonian Head of State**, which demands greater rigor from the LOC, which now has no room for error.
3. This is the very first time an African country has organized a NANBUDO competition of such magnitude.
4. A dissident international entity within the WNF is prepared to do anything to criticize and sabotage the event and discourage countries and/or competitors from participating in the Competition.

The **IOC President** will share all the above points and reiterate his firm commitment to ensuring the success of this major event by all necessary means.

The **Tournament Director** will conclude by drawing CINDA's attention to several points in the Competition Regulations that could pose problems or create conflicts during the Competition, and for which solutions must be found.

VII- Statement by CINDA (International Arbitration Commission)

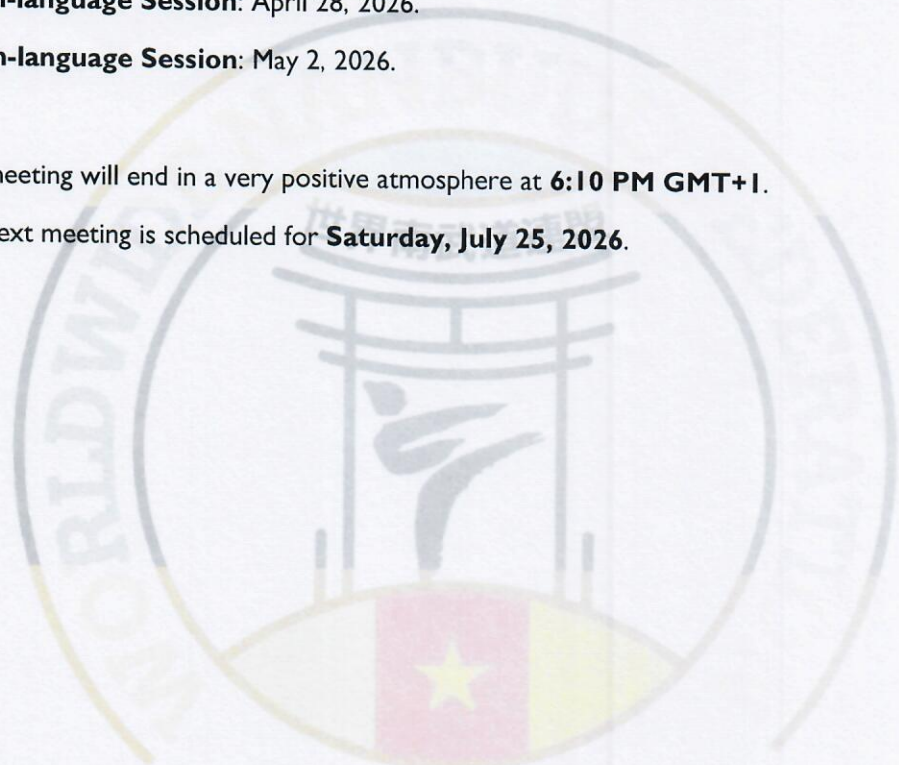
The CINDA Representative, **Me Armel LORI**, will speak, first offering apologies on behalf of the **CINDA President, who is unable to attend**. He will explain that the Competition Regulations were designed with a focus on the purely sporting aspect. He will acknowledge the observations made by the Tournament Director and state that adjustments to the Regulations may be made on a case-by-case basis as needed.

CINDA will then announce the organization of two online meetings to present and explain the Competition Regulations and to answer questions from the national representatives:

- **French-language Session:** April 28, 2026.
- **English-language Session:** May 2, 2026.

The meeting will end in a very positive atmosphere at **6:10 PM GMT+1**.

The next meeting is scheduled for **Saturday, July 25, 2026**.
