



VISA APPLICATION PROCEDURE ENTRY INTO CAMEROON



2026 WORLD NANBUDO CHAMPIONSHIP

In the framework of the organisation of the **2026 World NANBUDO Championship** in Cameroon, placed under the Very High Agreement and the High Patronage of His Excellency the President of the Republic, the official delegations are hereby informed of the provisions relating to the obtention of entry visas to the Cameroonian territory.

I- VISA APPLICATION PROCEDURE

All visa applications are submitted exclusively online via the official platform of the Cameroonian Government:

To this end, each member of the delegations (athletes, coaches, officials, accompanying persons) is required to:

1. **Create a user account on the e-Visa Cameroon platform;**
2. **Complete the online application form;**
3. **Upload all required supporting documents;**
4. **Pay the visa fees online;**
5. **Follow the instructions relating to validation and, where applicable, the collection of biometric data.**

II- DOCUMENTS TO BE PROVIDED (Digital Format)

The following documents must be provided in complete, legible and compliant form:

1. **Valid passport (minimum validity of six (06) months, with at least two blank pages);**
2. **Official invitation letter issued by the Local Organising Committee, specifying, where applicable, the terms and conditions of support;**
3. **Certificate of participation issued by the National Federation or by the World Federation of NANBUDO;**
4. **Return air ticket or confirmed reservation;**
5. **Travel insurance covering medical risks and repatriation.**

III- HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

In accordance with applicable international health regulations, participants are required to:

- 1. Be vaccinated against Yellow Fever;**
- 2. Be in possession of a valid International Vaccination Certificate upon their arrival on Cameroonian territory;**
- 3. Observe a recommended anti-malarial prophylactic treatment before, during and after the stay in Cameroon.**

Note 1: Other standard vaccinations (Hepatitis A and B, Typhoid, Meningitis, Tetanus – Diphtheria – Pertussis, Rabies) are strongly recommended.

Note 2: The Medical and Anti-Doping Commission of the Local Organising Committee of the 2026 World NANBUDO Championship requires, prior to any participation in the Competition:

- 1. Presentation of a Medical Certificate dated within the last three (03) months;**
- 2. Completion of certain medical examinations required by the procedures of the Ministry of Sports and Physical Education of the State of Cameroon (the list of examinations will be communicated at a later date);**
- 3. A Therapeutic Use Exemption Certificate for Athletes who are undergoing treatment with medications that may interfere with anti-doping tests.**

IV- SPECIAL PROVISIONS

In the framework of this international event:

- 1. Priority processing of applications may be granted to officially accredited delegations;**
- 2. Close coordination is ensured between the Local Organising Committee and the relevant authorities in order to facilitate the procedures;**
- 3. Federations and/or Delegations are invited to transmit, as soon as possible, the nominal lists of their participants.**

V- RECOMMENDATIONS

- 1. Anticipate administrative procedures in advance;**
- 2. Ensure the compliance and consistency of the information provided;**
- 3. Strictly observe the deadlines set in order to guarantee optimal participation in the event.**

The Local Organising Committee, in collaboration with the Ministry of External Relations of Cameroon, remains fully mobilised to assist delegations in the preparation and smooth conduct of their stay in Cameroon.
